*Currently there are no recommendations to close schools or cancel sporting or related events in South Africa. This is in keeping with the recommendations of the World Health Organisation.*

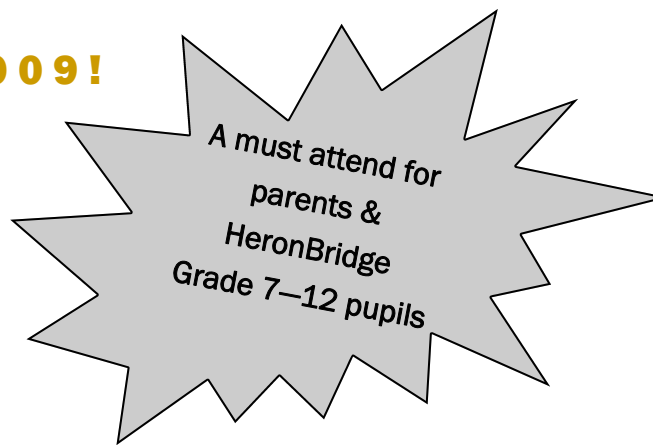

## FROM THE ECO COMMITTEE.....

Our Paper Recycling project, which started at the beginning of this year, is well underway, and the Eco Committee would like to thank all students and their parents for their fantastic support in the weekly paper drives etc. Please continue to collect your newspapers, boxes etc during the holidays, and send them in when school re-opens. ### Disposing of spent CFLs (Compact Fluorescent Lamps)

**These are the new bayonet or screw in type low wattage light 'bulbs'.**

Eskom advises that homeowners take the precautions they would normally follow when disposing of household hazardous waste and make use of one of the following options for CFL disposal that are available to South Africans at present:

- Deliver lamps to any of the retailers offering a take back service for CFL's. Currently Woolworths and Pick and Pay offer this service free of charge to the public.
- Deliver used lamps to existing electronic waste (eWaste) disposal sites and services. You can locate your closest site by logging onto the ewaste website <http://www.e-waste.org.za> or contact ewaste on 27 824 787 075.
- Store CFL's in a safe place, in a non breakable container or plastic bag to contain the bulb in the event of a breakage that might occur until infrastructure is in place for the safe disposal of CFL's in your area.
- Some Municipalities provide an annual or periodic hazardous waste collection day or event. Typically, CFL's along with any other household hazardous waste such as batteries, oil-based paint or motor oil can disposed of on these collection days. Check with your local authority whether these are available in your area.

Dispose with your general waste as a last resort. Any of the options listed above are preferred but you can lawfully dispose of CFL's in your household waste. Should you revert to this option, it is recommended that you wrap the bulb in newspaper and place in a plastic bag to reduce the risk of bulb breakage, contamination of other potentially recyclable materials and to protect yourself and waste removal staff from cuts.

In the case of breakage, the amount of mercury inside an individual lamp is too small to pose a hazard to users. Although the accidental breakage of a lamp is unlikely to cause any health problems, it's good practice to minimise any unnecessary exposure to mercury, as well as risk of cuts from glass fragments.

The following guidelines are therefore recommended in the case of accidental breakage of a CFL:

- Do not allow children or pregnant women to enter the affected area,
- Open windows and allow air to circulate to the affected area,
- Wear gloves, if available, as a precaution also against broken globes,
- First sweep up all of the glass fragments and phosphor powder (do not vacuum),
- Place in a plastic bag,
- Wipe the area with a damp paper towel to pick up stray shards of glass or fine particles,
- Place the used towel in the plastic bag as well

### HOLD YOUR LINE

Last Sunday morning we woke up when we felt like it, without the shrill ringing of an alarm clock in our ears. It was a rare occasion not having to be anywhere at a specific time. As our boys surfaced, one at a time they climbed into our bed for a family cuddle. It occurred to me that it had been many weeks since we had last done this and it felt so good to be taking the day minute by minute, being in the *now*, and not rushing. Our warm, fuzzy moment didn't last, however, as my youngest, Matthew (9), popped this question: "Please can I go and play on the computer?" There was a certain appeal for us as we could have caught an extra forty winks while he entertained himself, but the answer he got was: "No."

"No, because today we are staying put, and we are just going to enjoy being here together, pottering around, cooking together, playing together – just *being* together. He started to pout and the lip started to drop. And the huffing and puffing started. "But that's not fair, you're so horrible, you're such an ugly mother", and so it went on for a few minutes. But I held my line.
