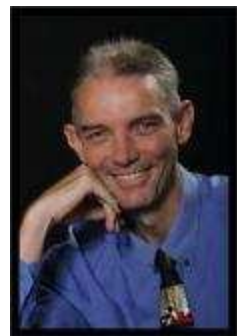
AWESOME EVENT! TALKING PARENTING

UPWARD SPORTS APRIL HOLIDAYS SOCCER AND NETBALL CLINIC

Wow, is it that time of year again! Yes it is and we are back bigger and better than ever! I have no doubt that you have had your HeronBridge Soccer or Netball fanatics coming home brimming with enthusiasm about Upward Sport 2009 – sorry, but it was announced on Friday 6th March 2009 in assembly!

Subsequently the enrolment forms have gone out, the Clinic dates have been confirmed as 27th April 2009 to 3rd May 2009! The workshops will be running from 09h00 to 12h00 daily with balanced teams consisting of 8 members, each with a dedicated coach! Children from Grade 1 to Grade 7 are eligible for enrolment. As the Clinic draws to a close we will host the exciting Round Robin Tournament, which is planned for the 2nd May 2009 from 09h00 to 15h00. The beauty of this tournament is that EVERYONE can be involved – no matter how old or young you are! Come and watch the children strut their stuff as they show off their newly acquired ball skills. Come and support the children with an early morning breakfast on the sides of the netball or soccer fields. There will be plenty of delicious rolls and drinks for sale. Make it a family affair - get involved, get excited but most of all, get there! The finale of the whole clinic will be the celebration service and prize giving held at the HeronBridge Community Church on the 3rd of May 2009. This is an awesome opportunity to share in fellowship and become involved in a great initiative where your children can only benefit – and best of all, there is no catch!

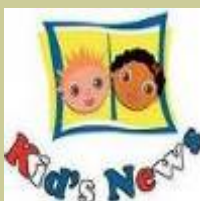
